Meister updated the audience on the TLSA Collaborative. A \$30,000 grand for the application process was rewarded by the USDA RD. Wade Trim has been hired to develop the boundaries and proceed with the application process.

A map of the boundaries is hanging on the wall in the Township.

Schwerdt updated the audience on the Preliminary Engineering Report that is in the development phase to Rural Development (RD). There are four municipalities involved and may get up to 50% of cost in grant money awarded. Key items are treatment options and collection options. RD sets the loan amount, grant amount, and the interest rate.

The loan will be paid for by Special Assessment. A single-family house equals 1 REU.

A determination needs to be made on how to assess vacant lots/non-buildable lots.

How are BNB's or Rental Units going to be addressed, Residential or Commercial?

What drives the income level? Median Household Income based on Census.

Maintenance costs are covered by a monthly fee.

USDA sets rates of what is charged, not the individual municipalities.
