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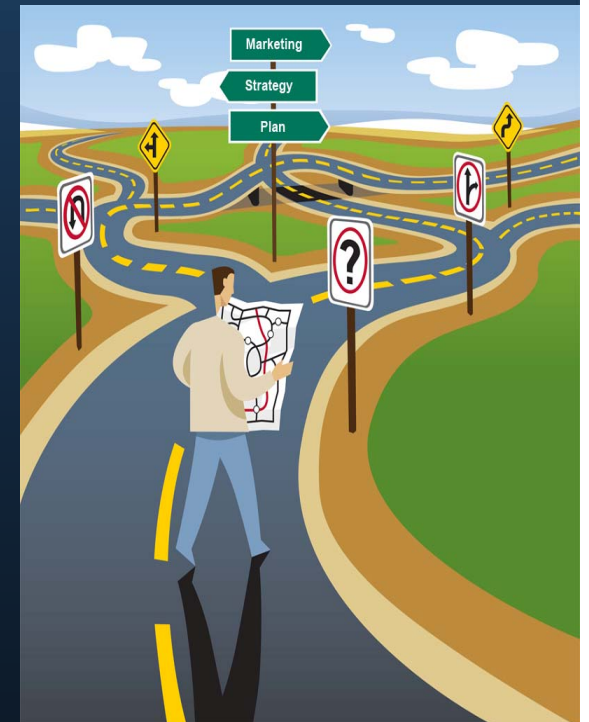

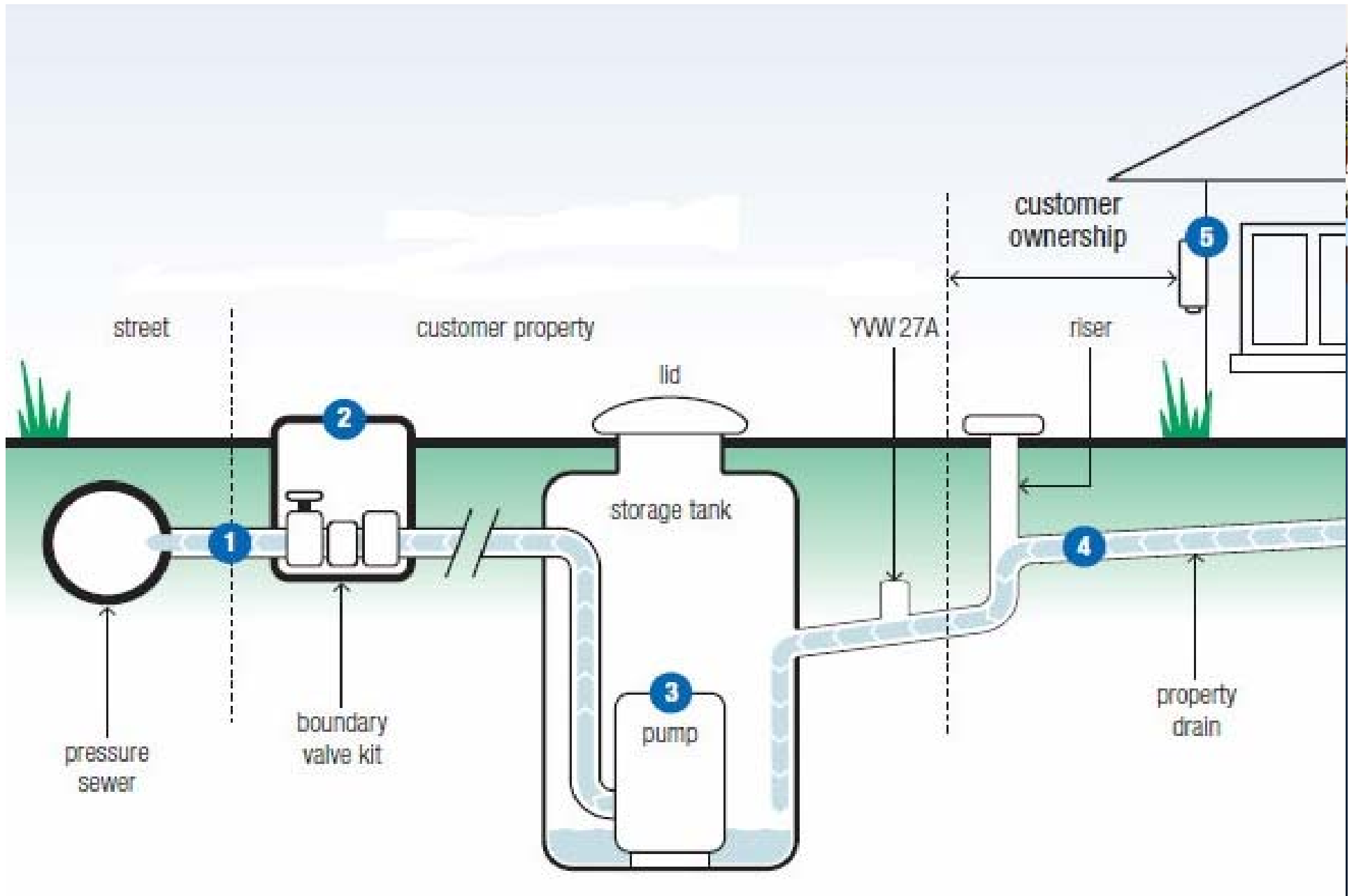

- Sewer collection system for “lakeshore properties”
- Delivery to a new WWTP

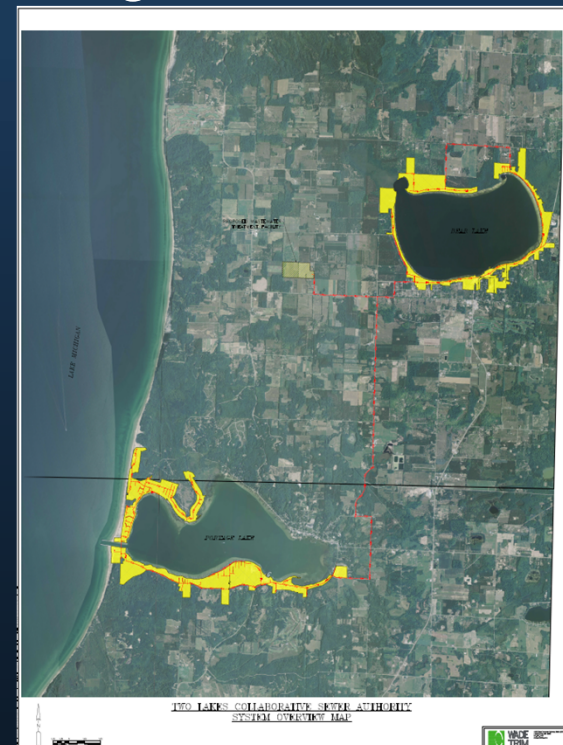

- Lakeshore properties around or near Portage and Bear Lakes
- Serving the following municipalities:
 - Bear Lake Township
 - Pleasanton Township
 - Village of Bear Lake
 - Onekama Township



What are the anticipated construction costs?




- There are four distinct segments to the project:
 - Portage Lake System \$18,000,000
 - Bear Lake System \$17,000,000
 - Wastewater Plant \$ 3,500,000
 - Transmission \$ 4,500,000
- Total: \$43,000,000



How will the Authority Pay for the System

- Special Assessment to cover construction
- Monthly user Rates to cover O&M

Potential Schedule



Full RD application submitted	September 2021
Receive Letter of Conditions	January 2022
Begin Design	April 2022
Finalize design/receive permits	June 2023
Open Bids	September 2023
Start Construction	April 2024

USDA RD Funding Application Status

- Complete full RD funding application
 - Revise Preliminary Engineering report
 - Environmental Review completion
 - Notice of intent & public hearing
 - Finish RDApply online application

Next Steps?

- Create Authority
- Apply for Planning Grant
- Complete RD Application
- Receive Letter of Conditions
- Assess conditions and potential user costs
- Complete design, permitting
- Hold bid opening
- Loan closing
