Baker Street work completed on July 8, 2022. 3rd Street and Brook Street intersection will be scheduled after Onekama Days.

PARKS

Lions' Club request for a variance of the noise ordinance until 1:00 a.m. on August 6, 2022. Trustee Miller moved, Trustee Arthur seconded to allow the variance. The motion carried.

Update on the Portage Lake Watershed grant. Special thanks to Lara Treemore-Spears, Mike Szokola, and the Manistee County Board of Commissioners for arranging to share GIS data at no additional cost to the village.

Consensus for the conceptual design sites: Onekama Schools Campus Two, Farr Center Parking Lot Four, Onekama Village Garage (DPW) Lot Five, Onekama Township Parking Lot Three , Onekama Village Park One.

Trustee Arthur moved, Trustee Halloran seconded to approve entering into a contract with GEI Consultants and/or Fleis and Vandenbrink not to exceed \$ 10,000 to complete green infrastructure engineering allowed by the grant. The motion carried.

Trustee Arthur moved, Trustee Schwing seconded to approve the land and / or easement ownership entities. The motion carried. The Village will own the property and will approach the Portage Lake Watershed Forever group to hold the conservation easement of the Krus property as allowed by the grant.

After discussion the consensus of the council approved fundraising for green stormwater infrastructure and land preservation. Lara Treemore-Spears agreed to head this effort.

Council discussed the executive summary of the Krus property environmental report.

Jetty repair project – all permits are in place – schedule is late summer or early fall

Memorial Bench donation The Onekama Class of 1980 will provide a memorial bench in the village park. The location and type of bench were approved and installation will be coordinated with the village after delivery.

Fountain issue Village is waiting on the garden club as instructed.

Beach buoys were installed on June 21, 2022
