- Discussion: We will be break even, make \$55,000 and spend \$55,000. Concernsthere may be some items in the wrong place, but that can be corrected as minor

changes. Storage and rental-we have one storage unit, rent the school and the park.

Donations-have it all go under administration? Roz Jaffe suggests that the donations be kept in each category, like Onekama Days. It will remain that way.

Julie Lapinski has a question about Fall Festival. Doesn't want to budget for the entire amount we received last year in donations. She wants a budget of \$1500. Budget amended to reflect this.

Banners and Lights-going with Amor. We have a contract for \$6200 for all the banners and lights, which includes an additional one time charge of \$400 for retrieving the lights from Grand Rapids. We will be crossing 2 budget periods.

Membership income may change. \$7200 from last year should be equal or more this year.

Will need to make sure that we have Beer/Pig Roast budget.

We have \$82000 now. Budget can be amended if need be.

Shoreline is still in the budget, may use another forum. Nikki Schneider is investigating.

Frank English moved to approved the 2022 Budget as amended; Seconded by Kyle Miller. Passed.
