#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**ZONING**: land use permits were issued for 4709 Main St and 5160 Main St.

--Trustee Burger (temp. ZA) has been contacted by the Manistee County PL Comm. regarding their county wide zoning services. Burger will have them come to the August council mtg with their presentation.

#### --Blight Committee:

Report was given by Matthew Kuizenga. Busy working on compiling addresses of property owners not in compliance with the blight ordinance. These will be given to the ZA to investigate.

## **PLANNING COMMISSION** – chair person has been notified to schedule a meeting. SEW**ER**

- --saw grant work continues and #7 grant request has been ordered.
- --heat related issues with the control cabinet at the irrigation station are being investigated.
- --President Franz had a meeting with Little Eden regarding their 3 phase upgrade project happening over the next 3 years which would eventually add 25 equivalents (additional ½ million gallons to our system). After this meeting President Franz, Trustee Burger and maintenance person Gronostalski met with DEQ in Cadillac to discuss if we have enough space for the additional effluent. This could be possible if we make changes (part 41) to our discharge permit which in turn would extend our irrigation

discharge. Lots of questions asked and answered. No action from the board but part 41 changes are being looked at.

#### STREETS:

-- **2019** street repairs: 3 sealed bids received: Elmer's/\$101,950. Reith-Riley/\$94,030.50 Ron Brown&Sons/\$57,853. After some discussion, Trustee Drumm moved, Trustee Burger supported to accept bid from Ron Brown to do the street repairs. Roll Call: Reitman/yes, Hudson/yes, Drumm/yes, Franz/no, Miller/yes, and Burger/yes. M/C.
