- Car Show (Scholarship). The PLA planning is going well. Mary Jo found the step by step manual. Linda is very happy to have this event. \$1058 in cash donations and things for goody bags. Have a license for the 50/50 auction. Hoping to have \$1500 to give as a scholarship. Westshore Community College Crystal Young drafted a proposal for a scholarship. We would give the proceeds to Westshore and they would administer it. We need to take the word annual out of the proposal. Diane moved to accept the contract with the removal of the word annual, Dave seconded. Motion carried. No dissent.
- Beer Tasting/ Pig Roast All going well. Poster has both Beer Tasting and Pig Roast. Feral Cats will be playing. Budgeted. Do we need the big tent? Could we get athletic boosters to help with the expense? Al will check on the tent sizes. Do we want to have a Fun Fish? Al will get more information.
- Fireworks. \$4500 in pledges so far. Need \$8000.
 - School & Scholarships Update. Money was donated to Senior trip and scholarships.
 - Board Member Vacancy. Kyle Miller has missed 3 meetings without any explanation, our bylaws allow us to remove. Dave Maylen moved that Kyle Miller be removed from the Board, Kathy Loynes seconded. Motion carried without dissent.
 - Welcome Committee. Diane got the list of new residents since last November, there are about 12 new. Diane has a list of things to include. If you order and use your own money, you can fill out a reimbursement form and submit to Evie. We have an account at Jackpine.
 - Petunia Parade Update. We haven't had rain for 4 weeks more or less. Valerie Clemons has gotten 60% of the plots to be watered by volunteers. Steve Hall puts about 800 gallons every day morning. We replaced 4 flats so far. Need a reminder about orange vests.

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- Concerts in the Park Brian is writing up information for press releases and newsletter. June
 26 is the first concert.
- PLA Branding. Had a meeting with the Mays, Al, Roz and Jean. Mays said they were confused about PLWF and PLA. They said we need to talk about our story. How have we affected the community.
