TOWNSHIP PARKS SUGGESTED RULES AND REGULATIONS: The commission was requested by the township board to review a proposed sample ordinance from the Regional Risk Manager of the Municipal Underwriters of Michigan (PAR PLAN), the township's insurance company. Suggestions for a proposed ordinance include prohibition of camping, glass bottles, open fires. Also place trash barrels in parks. Park only in designated areas; list hours that the parks can be used. The suggestions will be referred to the township board.

REWIEW WALL STREET JOURNAL ARTICLE ON: FAST INTERNET SERVICE INCREASES HOME DESIRABILITY AND SALES POTENTIAL: The commission discussed the article which points out that more house buyers are choosing where to live based on availability of high-speed networks. They also discussed the broadband availability, which could be useful in Onekama.
